Abstract

The subject of this study deals with abandoned properties within the limits of their nature as a state -owned satisfaction and as public funds, and as these properties are linked to their nature to the public benefit, the actions related to it were subjected to the rules and provisions of public law, but the legislator expanded its concept to tend to highlight a special state owned by the state once that Its link ended with the public benefit and subjected it to the rules of private law, and this study came with the aim of highlighting the effect of this expansion and touching some detail of the legislative provisions organizing it so that we can surround all its aspects and determine the legislative texts that are applied to them in cases of dispute over the rights related to it, This is done by enacting special legislation that regulates the provisions of abandoned lands, detailing the rights related to them and the permissible dispositions in accordance with the legislative expansion and the foundations on which they are based with their classifications related to public benefit.
