Abstract

This study dealt with the role of information technology in the preliminary investigation, as one of the most important means used to achieve prompt justice. This study aims to shed light on the legal basis created by the Jordanian legislator in the code of criminal procedure in article (158), in addition to creating special system for the use of technical means in criminal procedures. The researcher used the methodology of the descriptive and analytical method by extrapolating the new texts in the Code of Criminal Procedure and the system of using modern technological means in criminal procedures and analyzing them.
