International responsibility for the Israeli crimes committed in Gaza Strip

Abstract

This study discussed the issue of international responsibility for the crimes committed by Israel in the Gaza Strip, and holding accountable those who approved and carried out those crimes (soldiers, officers, and others), and trying them before the International Criminal Court. Because international law does not hold perpetrators of crimes accountable, but rather holds Israel internationally responsible through the International Court of Justice, this war resulted in great losses in the Gaza Strip. Wars can be reduced by holding the state that committed the crimes internationally responsible in order to achieve the main goal of the international community, which is to maintain international peace and security. This study aims to shed light on the Israeli violations and crimes committed in the Gaza Strip, and to hold Israel internationally responsible for these crimes and violations, and to punish the persons responsible for them before the International Criminal Court. The researcher used the analytical and descriptive method by analyzing the texts of international agreements and treaties, in addition to describing the reality of the Gaza Strip and the international violations it was exposed to. At the end of the study, the researcher reached a set of results and recommendations, the most important of which was that the Israeli crimes committed in the Gaza Strip were strictly in line with the Third and Fourth Geneva Conventions,

in addition to the application of the acts with the crimes stipulated in the Rome Statute of the International Criminal Court and the International Court of Justice, and they must be held internationally responsible for these crimes before the International Court of Justice, and those responsible for them must be punished. Crimes of leaders, soldiers and others before the International Criminal Court, and then the researcher recommended the necessity of the international community of countries and organizations to move to document all Israeli crimes committed in the Gaza Strip, and then present them to the International Criminal Court.
